

## **History of CPD**

The decision to establish an independent unit to initiate and supervise training in the National University was taken on 9<sup>th</sup> December 2009 due to magnificent and continuous growth and expansion of the programs of the college at that time. The expansion of the college-at that time- necessitates recruitment of new staff for the various departments. In order to maintain standards and criteria of the National College there was a need to establish a Centre to train and support staff to ensure excellence in education and services.

At the beginning it was given the name the Professional Educational Unit. By January 2011, the unit has its own, properly furnished hall in the National College (at that time). The name of the unit has been changed to the Centre for professional development - CPD.

In 2016 the Centre was moved to a new location with better facilities in Al Raqi Hospital- Main Campus of National University.

In a rapidly growing world of innovative knowledge and skills, it is essential to commit to quality, training and continuous development. Professional development is a process that enables individuals to maintain and improve standards of practice through the development of knowledge, skills and attitudes

To be a leading Centre for training, development and enhancement programs


#### The Aim:

- 4. Provide opportunities for the staff to reflect and provide feedback on their own practice.
- 5. Encourage and support research.
- 6. Empower the staff with both knowledge and skills necessary for improving the standard of the service provided.
- 7. Collaborate with national and international centers.
- 8. Encourage the staff to improve their professional effectiveness and work satisfaction.
- 9. Make use of unexpected opportunities –experts, visits –that can be beneficial to medical educators within the university.
- 10. Establish an interactive page within the university website and platform in order to provide online support for the staff.

# **CPD Organizational Structure**



### How do we determine the activities?

In the Centre, the program is planned and driven by staff and teachers' need through a form distributed (electronic and//or hard copy) and by the recommendation or advice input of the top management of the institute and by the CPD team according to an emerging need.

### **Activities:**

- Training workshops
- Journal clubs
- Meetings with individual departments or programs in the university
- Provision of support and advice to individual staff members within the university.
- Lectures by visiting professors.
- Review the curriculum for each faculty.

### **Evaluation:**

Credit points or CPD (continuous professional development) point's statement to be kept within the individual's personal record in the human resources department. An annual number of CPD points should be achieved .e.g.10 points /year. Successful completion of the CPD points would be certified.

Evaluation of the activities of the center is done through analysis of evaluation and feedback forms, reflection from the participants, and implementation of the annual calendar.

#### CPD POLICY AND PROCEDURES

#### 1. Introduction

The Centre for Professional Development, National University, Sudan (CPD-NUSU) is concerned with provision of training, support, advice and guidance to all staff members through continuous activities such as training workshops. CPD depends on its activities on the in house experts and when necessary external experts are invited. The appointment of each member of staff is followed by induction via orientation course that is held by CPD on regular basis to introduce the new staff member to the By-laws, regulations, policies and procedures and quality management concerns of the university. Each member of academic staff, who has not been exposed previously to adult education will be required to enroll in a Teaching Certificate course organized by the Center (CPD). This course is usually instructed by in-house expertise, but certain topics may necessitate the invitation of external experts from other universities or hospitals. Other activities include organization of courses by CPD to address an emerging needs such as E-learning.

### 2. Policy Statement

The CPD employs full-time educationists and invites guest experts to implement training for academic, professional and non-professional staff on educational, research and quality issues.

# 3. Purpose of the Policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that CPD:

- 1. Work in collaboration with top management of NUSU to observe its vision and mission.
- 2. Ensure in collaboration with the concerned faculties and departments all staff are equipped with current and updated skills and competencies in their specific era.
- 3. Control the process of training in the centre as from need assessment up to workshop planning, execution and evaluation.
- 4. Regulate the release of certificates to candidates who successfully attend and accomplish the assignment and tasks of the course.
- 5. Decide the validity of certificate and determine the need for renewal.
- 6. Regulate the workshops and candidate participation according to the need.
- 7. Arrange the relationship with external trainers and prepare a pool for potential external trainers based on their expert.
- 8. Avail facility of CPD advice and support to all and set a system of reward on educational research.
- 9. Create partnership with local, regional and global developmental centres
- 10. Preserve all the documents of its activities and ensure that abide by the quality management of the system
- 11. Evaluate the activities held by the centre using reflection, workshop evaluation, others using KPI.
